

2018-2019 SCHOLARSHIP NOTICE

The Scholarship Committee of the New England Chapter of the Society of Fire Protection Engineers is seeking candidates to receive awards from the A. L. Brown Scholarship Fund for the upcoming school year. The goal of this Scholarship is to encourage students to consider a career in engineering related to Fire Protection. In the past, the Chapter Board has voted to give away up to \$20,000 in scholarships, with up to \$10,000 to the named A.L. Brown Scholar.

An applicant shall be able to meet the following criteria as of September of the upcoming school year:

- Demonstrate a sincere interest in pursuing a career in fire protection engineering.
- Permanently reside in and have graduated from a secondary school located in Connecticut, Maine, New Hampshire, Massachusetts, Rhode Island, or Vermont OR currently attend a college or university located in New England.
- Be registered as a full-time student at an institution that has ABET - accredited curricula.
- Be matriculating towards a Bachelor of Science or graduate degree in an engineering discipline.

An applicant needs to submit a copy of the application form and any other information that would help the Committee in its selection (e.g. standard financial forms). The Scholarship Committee will evaluate each case separately on the basis of all facts submitted with a qualitative rather than quantitative emphasis.

The Chapter begins accepting applications in December 2018 for scholarships to be awarded in October 2019, and completed applications must be postmarked by February 25, 2019. Awards will be announced at the New England Chapter's Annual Meeting in May 2019. All candidates will be notified of the Committee's decision. Awards are made during the Chapter's regular October 2019 meeting, following confirmation of academic status and eligibility criteria.
